## PROGRAMS & SERVICES

We provide services for all veterans, Active Duty, Reserve, and National Guard members, regardless of discharge status.

### Rapid Rehousing

We offer short term rental and utility assistance for veterans and their families who are currently homeless or facing eviction.

### Temporary Housing

We offer temporary housing for more than 130 veterans each night that includes intensive case management, employment and legal services designed to help veterans obtain permanent housing and employment.

### Employment Services

Designated employment specialists help veterans overcome barriers so they can obtain meaningful employment.

### Food, Clothing, & Hygiene Pantry

Gently used clothing or non-perishable food or hygiene items are available at the pantry. The pantries are open on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
